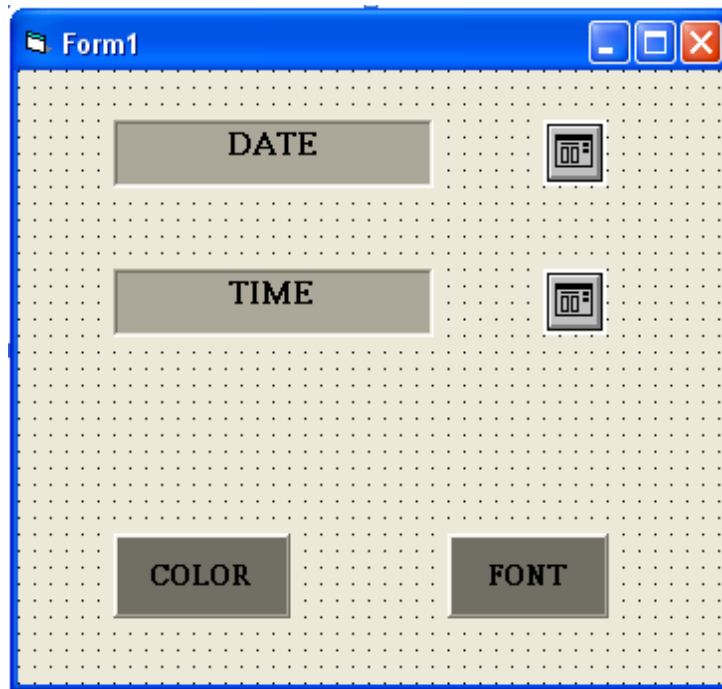


Program to create a form using Labels to display system date and time in appropriate form, font and color.

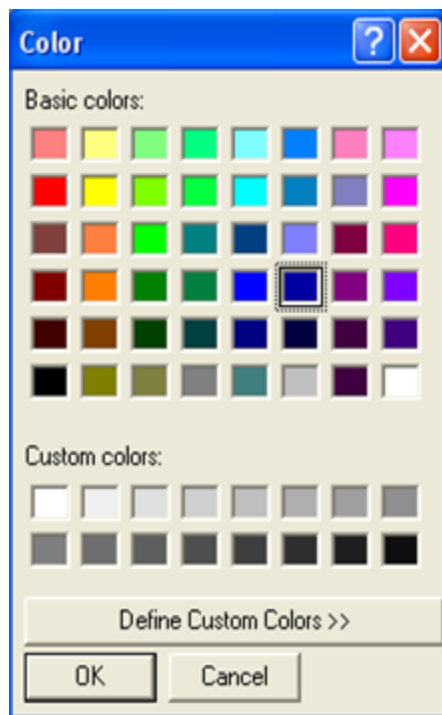
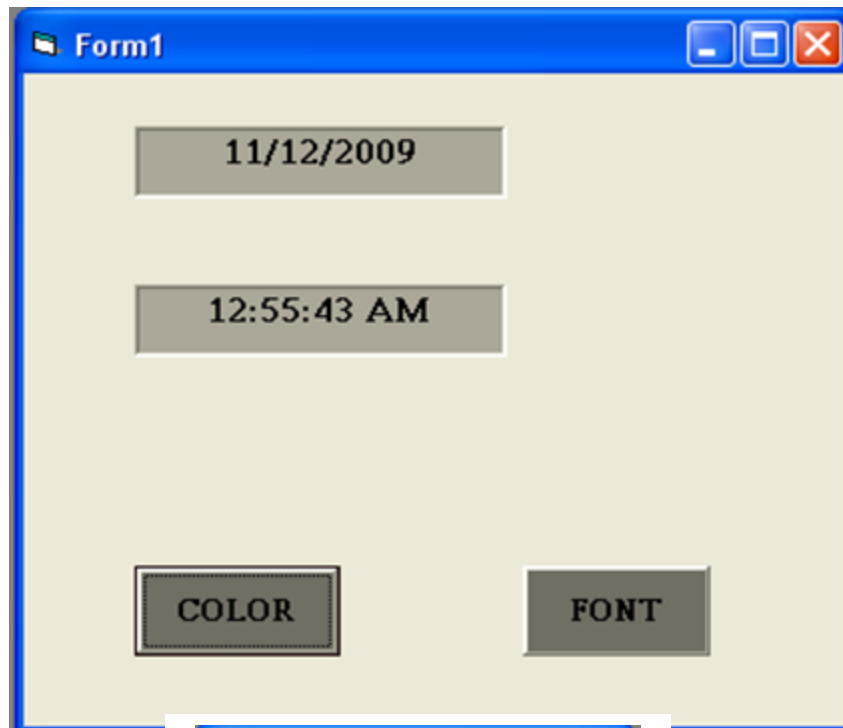
